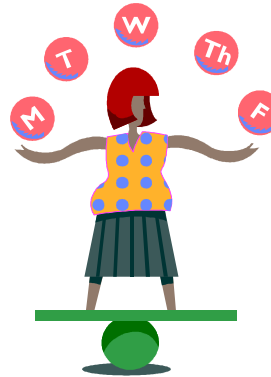
Who's back and who's going
