Featuring this week on Nunavimuit: **Snow Festival Part 5: Snow Sports**

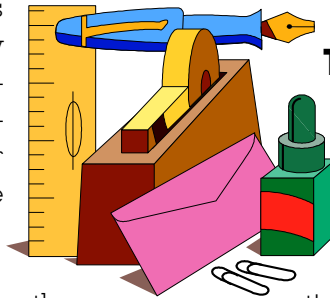
Make sure you tune in to Nunavimmiut on APTN this week to watch the Puvirnituaq Snow Festival Part 5: Snow Sports.
