Tune in to APTN on Tuesday for Nunavimut's program on Beluga in Nunavik.

The Beluga population is declining. The Elders of Nunavik have their theories and the scientists from the south have theirs. The two forces meet at the Maurice Lamontagne Research Institute in Mont Jolie to discuss all theories and scientific research information. The scientists have a chance to show their findings to the Elders but also have the opportunity to listen to the Elders explain their knowledge of the situation. Together they will discover how to work together to preserve the beluga population for future generations to come.

The show will be broadcast four times during the day on June 1st 2004. You could watch it at 11:00am, at 2:00pm, at 6:00pm, or at

11:00pm eastern time.

So make sure you tune in for some important wildlife information, which may affect yours and your childrens future hunting and eating habits.
