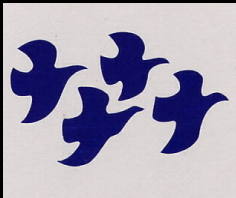

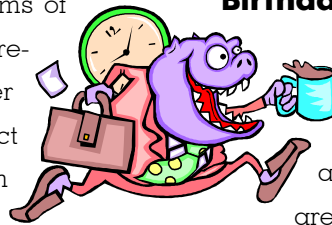
health, environment, prevention, and any other level; which may affect them. With their office in Ottawa, Jose Kusugak,
